## INSPIRE Day – 8<sup>th</sup> December 2005

### Actions:

#### Action 1: SDIC Registration

All GSE consortia to register with INSPIRE and create an appropriate thematic Spatial Data Interest Community (SDIC) ([http://inspire.jrc.it/sdic\\_call/index.html](http://inspire.jrc.it/sdic_call/index.html)).

- GSE INSPIRE WP managers to pass this action on their consortia primes.
- Provide both GSE INSPIRE WP manager and Prime Project Manager contact information.
- Inform Technical Officers when action is complete.
- Infoterra (D) will indicate reference to GSE Land on existing SDIC registration (GEOLAND)

#### Action 2: User Requirements from GSE Stage 1

All GSE Consortia to provide a **2/3 page document** indicating the GSE Stage 1 deliverable documents references containing the user and data requirements and user standards information for review by the INSPIRE Consolidation Team and drafting teams.

#### Action 3: Content to GSE Stage 2 Deliverable D4 (DRAFT)

All GSE Consortia to clarify what role each consortia will play relative to the INSPIRE activities (according to the possible roles included in the SOW). Each consortia to consult with respective partners and provide content covering consortium role/contributions to INSPIRE: i.e. which level and which domain do you want to play an active role? - testing, developing, training, or using INSPIRE output. This will include the following:

- Description of possible contribution to INSPIRE activities:
  - Implement rules for metadata
  - Possible tools development (current/future)
  - Overview of reference data use/needs (simple table)
  - Current and future data needs / development
  - Potential harmonisation of web portal activities
  - Possible data catalogues
  - Any other area of interest
- Service specifications: who gets what, when, where
- Common tools needed (e.g. use of EU catalog and publishing tools)

JRC/EEA will provide templates for Data and Service requirements (see action 4).

#### **Action 4: Content to GSE Stage 2 Deliverable D4 (DRAFT)**

JRC/EEA to provide the following templates to be completed by the GSE consortia and included in D4:

- Data input for user product specifications (based on current GSE SLA's)
- Service specifications: who gets what, when, where

**NOTE 1: GSE Deliverable D4 (DRAFT) with the above information is required by the INSPIRE team before end of February 2006.**

**NOTE 2: GSE Deliverable D4 V1 (Full version) due according to GSE Stage 2 SoW deliverable schedule.**

#### **Action 5: Feedback on data sharing/data access**

All GSE Consortia to send feedback on data sharing /difficulty on data access to support the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of INSPIRE.

#### **Action 6: INSPIRE contact information (*COMPLETED*)**

Brian Tittley to send out contact details of Inspire team to all consortia. (please see following 2 pages of this document)
